

Palo Alto 91B White "Thunderbolts" (U13) Fact Sheet

Practice Days:

- Twice a week. Additional coaching for goal keepers on Monday nights.
- Wednesday (Cub #3) Friday (Cub #1B), time 4-6 (**SUBJECT TO CHANGE**).
- Check email for cancellations or changes.

Games:

- Most games on Sunday in the fall, a couple on Saturday
- Attendance is mandatory in fall for all practices and games. Contact coach and manager for problems.
- Carpooling is encouraged; games are approximately as far north as South San Francisco and south to Morgan Hill. Ethel Mostrel is carpooling coordinator
- The regular Fall season runs from the beginning of August through the end of November (22-3).

Tournaments:

- September 27-8: Palo Alto Tall Trees
- October 25-26 Davis Fall Shootout (away)
- District Cup: 22-3 November
- May want to consider State Cup or Assn. Cup depending on how the season goes

Fees (per player) should have been paid in late spring:

- Palo Alto Soccer Club Fees \$100 for Fall (includes goalkeeper training, referee fees, equipment fees, PASC director of coaching salary, field usage maintenance fees, club scholarships)
- Redwood League Fees \$30 for Fall
- Coaching/Training Fees \$180 (\$45 per month per player)
- Tournament Fees \$65 (doesn't include anything beyond District Cup)
- Uniform approximately \$80; This will be collected separately by Anne Wein
- Social \$25
- Optional donation for scholarships for OUR players (to pay for above fees) \$15-30 (suggested)
- TOTAL: \$400 + any optional donation. Make checks payable to Thunderbolts Soccer Team.

- For fall: official Palo Alto Soccer Club uniform basic set (White & Navy jersey, White & Navy shorts, White & Navy socks)
- Optional warm up and sport bag available
